André Boucourechliev

Making his first Toronto appearance, this renowned composer, critic and pianist will offer a special lecture/presentation of his own music.

Born in Bulgaria in 1925, Boucourechliev studied at the State Academy of Music in Sofia, at the Ecole Normale de Musique in Paris, with Walter Gieseking at the Saarbrucken Conservatory and at the summer courses in Darmstadt. He has been associated with the Studio de Fonologia of the Italian radio in Milan, the Groupe de Recherches Musicales of the French radio, and since 1956 when he became a French citizen, has been music critic for many of the leading French newspapers and journals.

Currently a professor of musicology at Aix-en-Provence University as well as Olivier Messiaen's assistant at the Paris Conservatoire, Boucourechliev, whose compositions have been performed throughout the world, was awarded Le Grand Prix Musical in 1976 from the city of Paris.
