Become a New Music Concerts Member by buying one of our new Membership Packages. Custom design your own subscription series with tickets for concerts you will attend. With each ticket package of your choice you will receive a Member's Pass, your entry to New Music Concerts 1987-88 Season.

As a Member you will get one of the best seats in the house, reserved for Members' use only. You may choose one seat at each concert or use all tickets at once if you bring along some friends. Preferred Member's seats are held only until five days before the show although best available seating can be reserved right up until the evening of performance.

Membership will save you money while designing your own concert season!

Here's how it works.

Three Membership Packages are available:

Eight-ticket package, used for one seat at each concert, or any combination you prefer;

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Sixteen-ticket package, used for two seats at every performance, or any combination you prefer.

You select the concerts you plan to attend and decide how many tickets you want for each. Mark your ticket selections on the order form now and send it to New Music Concerts. Or, send the form for your Membership now and make your ticket choices at your convenience using your Member's Pass to order directly through the Box Office, Premiere Dance Theatre, Queen's Quay Terminal, 207 Queen's Quay West, Toronto, Ontario, M5J 1A7, 869-8444.

Remember you **must** present your valid Member's Pass at the Box Office in order to pick up your Member's tickets. Order your tickets early as designated Members' Seats and are allocated to Members on a first come, first served basis. Tickets may be exchanged for another seat or another performance through the Box Office for a service charge of \$1 per ticket. Regular tickets are \$13, \$7 for seniors and students.
