LONTANO

The ensemble LONTANO can be numbered amongst the most widely heard and regularly praised exponents of contemporary music. Since 1976, when the group originated as a brilliant iniatitive involving Royal Academy of Music students (in London) LONTANO has quickly grown into an experienced team. Over the last few years, under the energetic directorship of Odaline de la Martinez (herself a composer), it has acquired a formidable reputation as an ensemble combining individual virtuosity and teamwork in a wide range of music, from twentieth-century classics by Schoenberg, Varèse and Ravel to the latest compositions of up-and-coming figures who are still in their twenties.

On this present Canadian tour, LOTANO will be performing music by contemporary British and Canadian composers.
